



General Tax Authority launches the new tax portal "Dhareeba" and the deadline for the registration is 30 September 2020 according to the circular 3 2020 issued on 30 June 2020.

According to the provision No. 69 of the Executive Regulation of the relevant Income Tax Law issued under the Law No. (24) of the year 2018, all companies must address the GTA and fulfill all their tax obligations, via these online services as of the announcement date of its initiation. Moreover, all taxpayers registered at the time of implementing these electronic systems must correct their status and reprocess the registration at GTA in line with the provisions of this Executive Regulation within 90 days from implementing the Dhareeba system, which is 1-July-2020.

"Dhareeba" is an integrated digital platform for managing tax transactions in the State of Qatar. It's a new milestone that has been achieved by the General Tax Authority for digital tax transformation. This system enhances the effectiveness and efficiency in streamlining the entire processes.

Accordingly, the General Tax Authority (GTA) has announced the launch of the first phase of the new online tax administration system called 'Dhareeba'. The new Tax portal provides the General Tax Authority with digital channels to serve all its partners; the Government, tax agents, and the taxpayers. It has been designed to manage, calculate, and review various types of taxes to help taxpayers identify the procedures related to their transactions and receive notifications on the progress of their operations.

All companies are required to register on the new portal from 1 July 2020 and complete the registration process in a period of ninety (90) days. Taxpayers who register on the portal before 30 September 2020 will be exempted from the existing penalties related to previous registration and tax card issuance. **In other words, all taxpayers that did not register before and obtained a Tax Card will be exempted from penalties provided that the registration must be completed on 30 September 2020.**



All companies are required to register for Dhareeba, including the companies that have a valid Tax Card. The companies have to use the username and password they regularly use in the Hukoomi or e-government portal in the ministries. When you enter the system, you start the registration process, and you have to choose our office **Antonio Ghaleb and Partner CPA** from the list of auditors approved at the General Tax Authority.

Highlights

- All companies are required to register for “Dhareeba”, including the companies that have a valid Tax Card.
- All taxpayers that did not register before and obtained a Tax Card will be exempted from penalties provided that the registration must be completed on 30 September 2020.
- The companies have to use the username and password they use in the Hukoomi or e-government portal in the ministries
